ELIMINATE WATER & SEWER CAPITAL RECOVERY FEES ON ELIGIBLE NEW HOMES!

The City of Harrisonburg's Public Utilities Department is responsible for providing water and sewer services. During new construction, customers pay connection charges and capital recovery fees for water and sewer installation. Through the Affordable Housing Fee Waiver Program, the City can waive water and sewer capital recovery fees for developers who build new affordable housing.

- 5. Buyer is within 100% Area Median Income

Requesting Fee Waivers:

- <u>Fee Waiver Reservation</u>: Applicants may provide information about anticipated qualified units at any time; a Fee Waiver Reservation may be <u>emailed</u> to the Housing Coordinator after obtaining a building permit. The City will review preliminary eligibility / availability and notify applicants of fund reservation.
- <u>Fee Waiver Request</u>: Applicants pay all required fees to the Public Utilities Department, complete construction, and finalize the unit sale. Afterwards, the Fee Waiver Request can be <u>emailed</u> to the Housing Coordinator for processing and reimbursement.
